

NOTICE OF ASSEMBLY

Grand Junction Regional Airport Authority

This is to notify of an assembly of the Board of Commissioners for the Grand Junction Regional Airport.

What: The Grand Junction Regional Airport Authority recently engaged the services of Aviation Management Consulting Group (AMCG) to assist the Authority with the review and update of the Requirements and Minimum Standards for Commercial Aeronautical Services and Activities (Minimum Standards) for the Grand Junction Regional Airport.

Minimum Standards are one of a compendium of policies, standards, guidelines, rules, and regulations that govern the operation, management, and development of an airport that are commonly referred to as Primary Management Compliance Documents (PMCDs). PMCDs include Rules and Regulations, Minimum Standards, Leasing/Rents and Fees Policy, and Development Standards, each of which is described in more detail below. In combination, these PMCD documents are designed to: (1) ensure the long-term financial health of an airport, (2) facilitate (foster) the orderly development of an airport, (3) ensure the provision of quality products, services, and facilities at an airport, (4) protect the health, safety, interest, and general welfare of the public, and (5) reduce the potential for conflict with lessees, operators, consumers, and users.

Within the process of this review and update of the Requirements and Minimum Standards for Commercial Aeronautical Services, AMCG has put together the opportunity for an educational short course and public forum.
